# How To Get To The Academy

**BY RAIL:** Take the Long Island Railroad from Pennsylvania Station, 34th Street at 7th Avenue, New York City. Take Port Washington line to Great Neck (about 30 minutes). Buses run from the Great Neck Station to the Academy. Taxi also available.

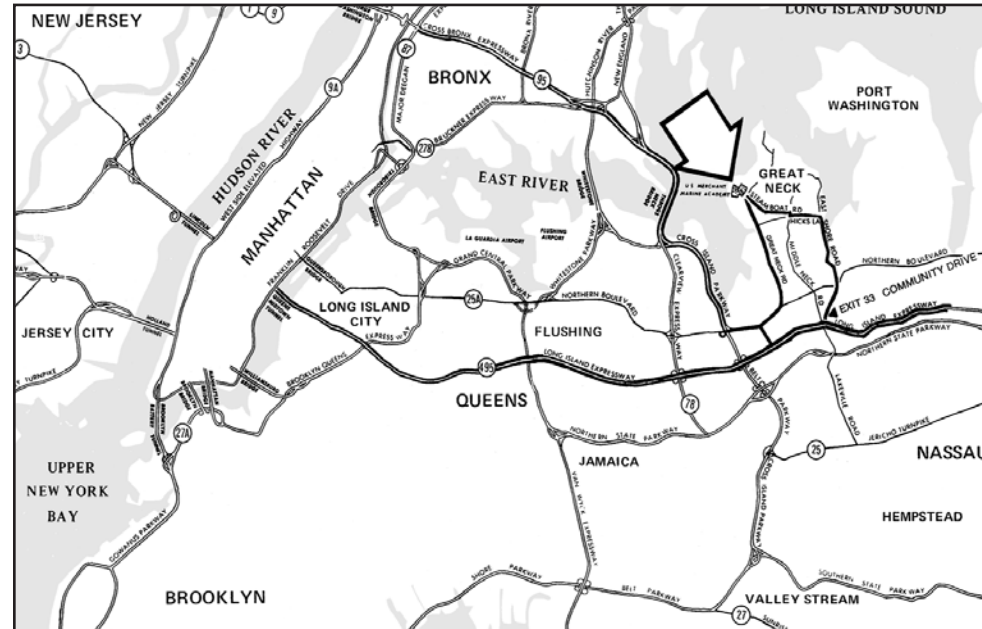
**BY AIR:** From LaGuardia or John F. Kennedy International Airports, take Long Island Limousine Service to Northern Boulevard and Lakeville Road in Great Neck. Taxi to the Academy.

**BY AUTO: *From George Washington Bridge:*** Take Cross Bronx Expressway (I-95) to the Throgs Neck Bridge. Take the first right-hand exit after crossing bridge onto the Cross Island Parkway South. Take the Cross Island Parkway South to Northern Boulevard East (Exit 31-E). Travel 1.6 miles on Northern Boulevard; take left fork onto Great Neck Road. Follow this road, which changes names to Bayview Road, past the Great Neck Public Library on right. After three miles, turn right at 4-way stop onto Kings Point Road. Take Kings Point Road to next 4-way stop, turn left onto Steamboat Road. Proceed one block to Academy main gate.

***From Lincoln Tunnel:*** Through Lincoln tunnel onto 34th Street to Mid-Town Tunnel. Through Mid-Town Tunnel onto Long Island Expressway (I-495 East). Follow Expressway to Exit 33 (Lakeville Road). Turn left onto Lakeville Road and proceed for 3.5 miles through the village of Great Neck. Turn left at light onto Steamboat Road, proceed one mile directly to the Academy Main Gate.

***From Verrazano Bridge:*** After crossing bridge take the Brooklyn-Queens Expressway (I-278 East). Follow BQE to the Long Island Expressway (I-495 East). Exit right onto the LIE East and follow directions as above from Lincoln Tunnel.

***From Eastern Long Island:*** Long Island Expressway West to Exit 33 (Community Drive, Lakeville Road). Turn right at the second light onto Lakeville Road and proceed for 3.5 miles through the village of Great Neck. Turn left at light onto Steamboat Road, proceed one mile directly to the Academy main gate.

**Founding Date:** September 30, 1943.

**Operation:** Federal academy operated by the Maritime Administration of the U.S. Department of Transportation.

**Mission:** To educate and graduate professional officers and leaders of honor and integrity who are dedicated to serving the economic and defense interests of the United States in our Armed Forces and Merchant Marine, and who will contribute to an intermodal transportation system that effectively ties America together.

**Accreditation:** Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools. The Marine Engineering Systems curriculum and the Marine Engineering and Shipyard Management curriculum are accredited by the Engineering Accreditation Commission (EAC) of the Accreditation Board for Engineering Technology (ABET).

**Enrollment:** 950 men and women.

**Degrees and Credentials Awarded:** Bachelor of science degree. Merchant marine license as third mate or third assistant engineer. Reserve or active duty appointment as a commissioned officer in the U.S. Armed Forces.

**Program:** Four years, including two periods at sea on U.S.-flag merchant vessels.

**Curricula:** Marine Transportation, Marine Engineering, Marine Engineering Systems, Marine Engineering and Shipyard Management, Maritime Operations and Technology, Logistics and Intermodal Transportation.

**Faculty:** 80; student-faculty ratio, 12:1.

**Campus:** 82 acres, 28 buildings; extensive waterfront facilities; more than 100 vessels and small craft.

**Location:** Kings Point, New York, 20 miles from New York City on Long Island.

**Library:** Accommodations for 300 readers and 180,000 volumes; special collections, periodicals, charts, archives, rare books, microfilm, microfiche, audio visual equipment, on-line index.

**Student Activities:** Band, Glee Club, Newspaper, Yearbook, Debate Council, Sailing Squadron, numerous clubs, honor societies, professional society chapters, lectures and concerts, voluntary religious program, museum exhibits, varsity sports, intramurals, social events.

**Visiting Hours:** 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily and weekends. Closed on Federal holidays.
