

## STUDENT IDENTIFICATION AND ACCESS CREDENTIALS

Prospective students planning to attend the USMMA will need to obtain a government form of identification (PIV-I). The credential provides the student:

- A government form of identification, or Student ID;
- Access to government IT infrastructure;
- Access to secure dormitories and other protected USMMA facilities.

The process to obtain a PIV-I consists of the following:

- The prospective student, sponsored by the USMMA, will complete registration at the USMMA site. Early registration is highly encouraged, if you are in the local area on a visitation, or if you arrive in the local area in the days prior to indoctrination, please report to the Department of Public Safety in Furusetth Hall. - During indoctrination, the student will process through Public Safety, complete the registration process and be issued their PIV-I card.
- Students will need two forms of official identification to present to Public Safety and complete the registration process to receive their PIV-I card. **Copies of documents cannot be used. State Driver's License or ID must comply with REAL ID Act of 2005.**

### Forms of Official Identification
