Service Academy Day

A **congressional service academy nomination** is a formal recommendation from a member of the **U.S. Congress**—either a **Senator** or a **Representative**—that provides the legal authority for a service academy to consider a candidate for admission. Required for four of the five federal academies (the **U.S. Military, Naval, Air Force, and Merchant Marine** academies), this competitive process involves a "whole person" evaluation of an applicant's academic achievements, leadership potential, physical aptitude, and character. Most students apply to their local Representative and both of their state's Senators, as receiving a nomination is a mandatory first step toward earning an "appointment," or offer of admission, from an academy's admissions board.
